## TGK Vaccination Program

We do not advise or recommend vaccination programs to our clients. We would strongly encourage that you establish a Vet-Client relationship with a local Vet practice who can tailor your immunization program needed for your geographical area. We have put our current immunization program in writing to help our customers and their veterinarians understand what we have done prior to the purchase of the puppy or adult dogs. This program has been used on our adult dogs and is required with a signed health certificate stating the immunization status of the dogs that we raise and train here. Accurate immunization records are important while most states are now requiring this for interstate travel.

Week 1. Dock tails and remove dewclaws.

Week 2. Deworm puppies with paste or liquid dewormer like Strongid or Nemec.

Week 4. Feed moistened puppy food and fresh water often.

Week 6. Deworm with Fenbendazole dewormer.

Week 8. Immunize Canine with Da2PP (Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, Parinfluenza, Parvovirus). Deworm with Fenbendazole dewormer.

Weeks 9 & 12. Immunize Canine with Da2LPP +CVK (Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, Coronavirus, Parinfluenza, Parvovirus, Leptospira Bacterin).

Immunize Canine Bordetella Bronchiseptica. Deworm with Fenbendazole dewormer.

Week 16. Immunize Canine with Da2LPP (Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, Parinfluenza, and Parvovirus) Modified Live Virus, Canine Bordetella Bronchiseptica. Deworm with Fenbendazole dewormer. Immunize 1-year Rabies vaccination.

Adult Dogs. Annual Da2LPP+CVK and rotate intranasal and subcutaneous Canine Bordetella Bronchiseptica. Monthly prevention of Heartworm and external parasites, monitor sample stools quarterly for internal parasites and treat accordingly.

Vaccination for Borrelia Burgdorferi may be recommended in areas of high tick infestation. Consult your veterinarian regarding this particular vaccination program!

Heartworm preventative should be administered monthly.
